CENTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

The subdivision of T5S, R39E, W.M. was originally surveyed by David P. Thompson under General Land Office Contract No. 103, approved February 15, 1864. The field notes for this survey state:

"Set post for $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner in mound of stone"

This corner was recovered by J.W. Kimbrell, Deputy Union Co. Surveyor, in 1887 on page 22 of the Union County Old Survey Book, He states: A post in mound of stone.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a stone mound 4 ft. in diameter, 1 ft. high with large stones 18" - 24" in length, with bottom remnant of wood stake, buried 15 in. below ground at center of mound.

A stone mound with old fence post lies 5 ft. West of corner, old fences run South and West from post.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES LESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At center of found mound of stones: Set a 31/4 in. diameter aluminum cap on a 21/2 in. diameter by 30 in. long aluminum post, buried 15 inches into the ground with clear Berntsen DEEP-1 magnet at base, rebuilt magnet magnet at base, rebuilt magnet at base, rebuilt magnet magnet at base, rebuilt magnet mag stone to top of monument, t-post placed alongside 1.70 ft. NE'ly, marked as shown:

From which lestablish the following reference monuments:

A $\frac{5}{8}$ in. diameter by 30 in. long iron rod (rebar) with a $\frac{1}{2}$ in. diameter aluminum cap, driven 23 in. into the ground, mkd.: "ODOT NE" bears N38°E, 8.98 ft.

A $\frac{5}{8}$ in diameter by 30 in long iron rod (rebar) with a $\frac{1}{2}$ in diameter aluminum cap, driven 16 in into the ground, mkd.: "ODOT SE" bears S43°E, 9.16 ft.

A blue Berntsen DEEP-1 magnet, buried 4 in. into the ground, bears S44° W, 10.16 ft.

An orange Berntsen DEEP-1 magnet, buried 4 in into the gound, bears N52°W, 8.02 ft.

Accessories taken with steel tape and hand compass set at 19° East declination.
