

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO

MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:
At position by Survey I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, with 2' diam. collar of stone, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8"x 30" iron pin with 1 ½" aluminum cap bears South 25° 58' East, a dist. of 9.46 ft., marked SE RP


A 5/8"x 30" iron pin with a 1 ½" aluminum cap bears North 44° 08' West, a dist. of 16.53 ft., marked NW RP
