
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by W.B. Barr under GLO contract number 443 dated June 29, 1882. Surveyor General record states:

Set tamarack stake 4 ft long 4 in diam for corner to sec 13,14,23,24 from which;

A tamarack 3 in diam bears $N52^{\circ}E$ 19 1ks dist A pine 6 in diam bears $S52^{\circ}E$ 6 1ks dist A fir 5 in diam bears $S41^{\circ}W$ 23 1ks dist A fir 10 in diam bears N30W 28 1ks dist



No record of subsequent remonumentation found Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 28 inch diameter White Fir $N30^{\rm o}W$ 28 lks live and vigorous with scribes visible and BT blaze evident


A 11 inch diameter Red Fir bears N62°E 45.43 feet marked T5S R40E S13 BT

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with 54-9 sign
