




New BTs

A 14 inch diameter Red Fir bears S43°W 22.70 feet marked E 1/16 S24 BT A 17 inch diameter White Fir bears N60°W 14.07 feet marked E1/16 S13 BT

Set steel fenceposts approximately 5 feet West with 54-2 sign and approximately 5 feet South with 54-2 and 54-9 signs attached

Corner set May 27, 1986 Witness: Rick Robinson





Brass washer marked OPLS 644 nailed to BT blaze. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° East declination. Distances to the BTs are to a 50d spike set in right side of tree when facing tree, unless otherwise stated.
