




A 12 inch diameter P.Pine bears S57°E 1.72 feet marked X BT

A 17 inch diameter P.Pine bears S47°W 2.52 feet marked C4 S24 BT

Set steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with 54 + 9 sign attached

Brass washer marked OPLS 644 nailed to BT blaze. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 200 East declination. Distances to the BTs are to a 50d spike set in right side of tree when facing tree, unless otherwise stated.
