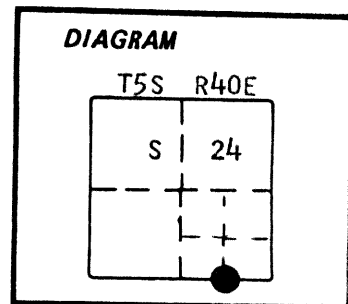


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground with a small mound of stone from which:

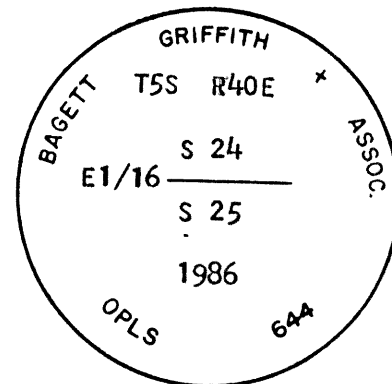
New BTs

- A 8 inch diameter White Fir bears S60°E 24.93 feet marked E1/16 S25 BT
- A 13 inch diameter Tamarack bears N12°W 14.44 feet marked E1/16 S24 BT

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with 54-2 sign and approximately 5 feet North with 54-2 and 54-9 sign attached

Corner set May 30, 1986

Brass washer marked OPLS 644 nailed to BT blaze. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 20° East declination. Distances to the BTs are to a 50d spike set in right side of tree when facing tree, unless otherwise stated.
