

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with 2 1/2" aluminum cap, 30 inches in the ground, from which:

- A 6 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 26° West, a distance of 71.25 feet, marked X BT.
- A 16 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 9° West, a distance of 44.70 feet, marked W 1/16 S32 BT.


I set a steel fencepost 1 foot South of the corner monument.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the accessories. I used 16° East declination, the distance to the bearing trees are to a 60d spike driven into the root crown at the right side of the tree. I place a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower blaze of the accessories.
