


History of original corner establishment:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a 2½ × 3011 aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 14 inches in the ground and raised a mound of stone with a 5 foot base to top of cap, from which:

A 12 inch Douglas Fir bears S 5° E, 27.45 feet, Marked E 1/16 S 4 BT.

A 10 inch Ponderosa Pine bears N 69° W, 13.69 feet, marked E 1/16 S 33 BT.

I set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet West with a 54-9 sign attached.


