
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner originally established by Henry M. Thatcher under GLO contract number 320 dated April 1, 1879. Surveyor General record states:


Set stone 15x13x7 for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor Raised stone mound at cor

A 13 inch diameter White Fir bears N 89° E , 6.76 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 35 BT. A 16 inch diameter White Fir bears S 4° E, 16.17 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 BT.

Set steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with 54-4 sign attached
