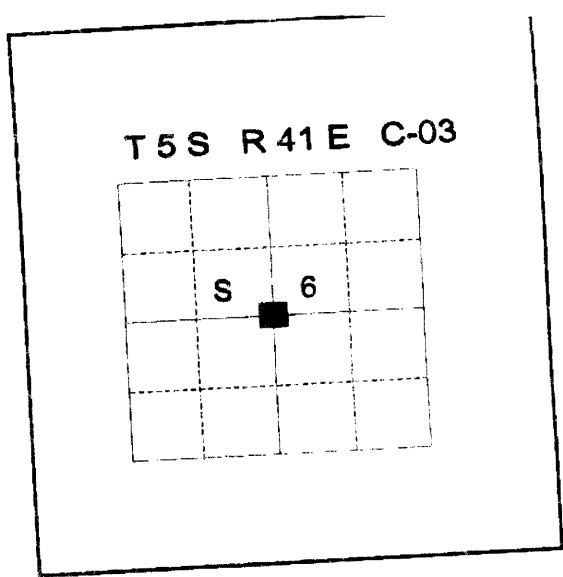


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner not previously established

No record of subsequent monumentation found in UNION COUNTY survey records.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 24" in the ground from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

- A 11 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears North 54° East, a distance of 33.51 feet marked C 1/4 S6 BT
- A 16 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears South 33° East, a distance of 81.32 feet marked C 1/4 S6 BT
- A 15 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears South 86° West, a distance of 49.90 feet marked C 1/4 S6 BT
- A 14 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears North 41° West, a distance of 11.55 feet marked X BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument 3 ft. base to top of cap.
Set a steel fence post approximately 1 feet East of the corner monument.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination. The distance to the new accessories is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze.
