

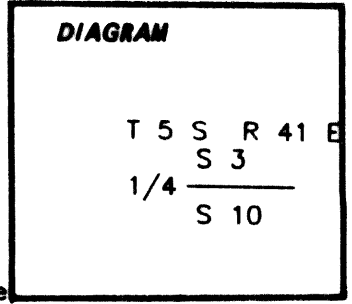
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

In 1879, Henry M. Thatcher, under contract 320, "Set stone 13X9X5 for 1/4 sec. cor. From which  
A Pine 5 in. in dia. bears N80°E, 10lks. dist.  
A Fir 10 in. in dia. bears S45°W, 36 lks. dist.

In 1990, Philip G. Griffin, BLM, under Group No. 1000 & 1484 states:  
"Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 10 at proportionate distance there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. From which:  
T 5 S R 41 E A larch, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 79° E., 36 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S3 BT.  
S 3 A larch, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 33 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S10 BT."

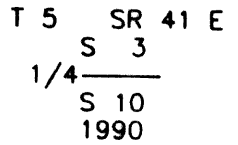


Description of corner evidence found:

Found:

A stainless steel post, 6 ins. above ground, 2 1/2 ins. diam., with BLM brass cap mkd.  
From which

A larch, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 79° E., 23.8 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S3 BT.  
A larch, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 21.8 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S10 BT.



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From the 1990 BLM monument new bearing trees

A larch, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 13° E., 38.4 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S3 BT.  
A larch, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 16 1/2° W., 85.7 ft. dist., mkd. 1/4 S10 BT.

The trees are double blazed, with a brass washer, mkd. LS 2211, nailed between the B & T.

Tools used; hand compass (declination 19.5° East) and a 200 ft. Kesson tape.
