

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin, 25 inches in the ground, with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, from which:

- An 18 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South $78\,^{\circ}$ East, a distance of 14.15 feet, marked CS 1/16 S8 BT.
- An 11 inch Ponderosa Pine bears South 23° West, a distance of 7.40 feet, marked CS 1/16 S8 BT.
- I set a steel fencepost approximately 1 ft. North of the corner.
- I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on December 9, 2013.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 16° East declination. The distances to the new bearing trees are to a 60d spike driven into the root crown at the right side of the bearing trees. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the BT blaze.
