

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

## TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin, 30 inches in the ground, with 2 ½" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, from which:

- A 15 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 46° East, a distance of 22.75 feet, marked S 1/16 S9 BT.
- A 9 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 49° West, a distance of 9.00 feet, marked S 1/16 S8 BT.

I set a steel fencepost approximately 1/2 ft. North of the corner. Corner falls 2 feet East of a South running fenceline, approximately 35 feet East and 15 feet North of a fence corner, from which the fences run North and West.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on December 9, 2013.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used  $16^\circ$  East declination. The distances to the new bearing trees are to a 60d spike driven into the root crown at the right side of the bearing trees. Bearings are to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the BT blaze.
