History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Henry M. Thatcher under GLO Contract No. 320, dated April 1, 1879. The Surveyor General Record states:

In 1990 the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) conducted a dependent resurvey in T.5S., R.41E., W.M., under Group Nos. 1000 and 1484. This survey was executed by Philip G. Griffin, Cadastral Surveyor and commenced July 9, 1990 and was completed April 13, 1992. The following is the BLM's record for this corner:

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base and the S14 BT. Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base and the corner stone alongside the stainless steel post. Raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 1% ft. high, W. of the corner.

Found a 2%" dia. stainless steel post with brass cap marked as shown in diagram, in a large mound of stone, 3 ft. at base, 6 inches high. Monument is solid and in good condition.

A Ponderosa Pine, 15" dia., with blaze pitched over, bears N89°W, 7.26 ft. (Established by BLM)
