

A ponderosa pine, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 72½° E.,  
88 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S24 BT.

A ponderosa pine, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 16° W.,  
91 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S23 BT.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base and the  
corner stone alongside the stainless steel post.

N. 1° 45' 00" E., beginning new measurement.

Descend steep, broken NE. slope to South Fork of Catherine Creek;  
thence over spur.

North Fork of Catherine Creek, 100 lks. wide, course S. 70° W.;  
continue over creek bottom land.

Graveled road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 80° E. and S. 70° W.; asc.  
S. slope.

The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23, and 24, monumented with the original  
basalt stone, 14 x 12 x 6 ins., loosely set 3 ins. in the ground,  
with no clear marks. (Loose alongside find an ancient broken wood  
signboard predating 1953 by its designation of this place as the  
boundary of the Whitman National Forest.)

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.  
in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with  
brass cap mkd.

A Douglas fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 86½° E.,  
62 lks. dist., mkd. T5S R41E S13 BT.

A Douglas fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 3° E., 89 lks.  
dist., mkd. T5S R41E S24 BT.

A ponderosa pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W.,  
68 lks. dist., mkd. T5S R41E S23 BT.

A Douglas fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 89° W., 179 lks.  
dist., mkd. T5S R41E S14 BT.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base and the  
corner stone alongside the stainless steel post.

Raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of the corner.
