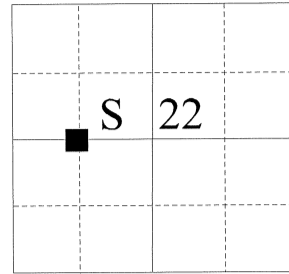

**BEARING TREES:**  
A 14 in. Western Larch bears North 79° East, a distance of 52.66 feet, marked CW 1/16 S22 BT.  
A 9 in. Douglas Fir bears South 3° East, a distance of 30.07 feet, marked CW 1/16 S22 BT.

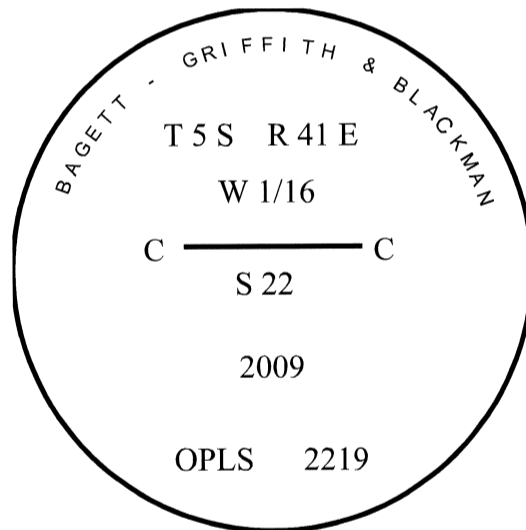
I hereby certify that the corner was set on December 2, 2009.
