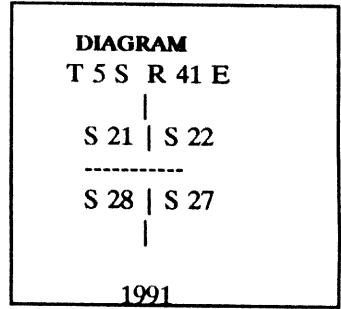


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

80.00 The cor. of secs. 21,22,27, and 28,monumented with the original slate stone, 14 x 12 x 6 ins., loosely set at the center of the remains of an old stone mound, with 4 grooves on one face. Alongside find a water pipe, 2 ins. diam., firmly set flush with the ground, with metal washer mkd. CX 23 1973. At the corner point set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap, from which:



- A ponderosa pine, 13 ins. diam., bears N.51°E., 95 lks. dist. mkd. T5S R41E S22 BT.
- A ponderosa pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S.24°E., 90 lks. dist. mkd. T5S R41E S27 BT.
- A ponderosa pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S.22°W., 41 lks. dist. mkd. T5S R41E S28 BT.
- A ponderosa pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N.57°W., 47 lks. dist. mkd. T5S R41E S21 BT.
- A corner of wire fences extending S. and E., bears S. 30° E., 0.130 chs. dist.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base of the water pipe within, and the corner stone alongside the stainless steel post.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 2½" B.L.M. brass cap, 5" above ground, with a 1' mound of stone to cap from which:

- A pine, 14" diam., bears N.50°50'E., 62.79', with a 22" x 3" blaze (not legible).
- A pine, 17" diam., bears S.24°30'E., 59.76', with a 19" x 4" blaze (not legible).
- A pine, 16" diam., bears S.21°12'W., 26.71', with a 18" x 4" blaze (not legible).
- A pine, 15" diam., bears N.57°02'W., 30.26', with a 18" x 4" blaze (not legible).

157 lks. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S28 BT.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base of the
stainless steel post.

60.10 Barbed wire fence, bears E. and W.

63.00 Graveled road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.

67.00 Oregon State Highway No. 203, paved, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 40° W.
and S. 40° E.; continue along broken W. slope along wire fence.

A ponderosa pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 22° W.,
41 lks. dist., mkd. T5S R41E S28 BT.

A ponderosa pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 57° W.,
47 lks. dist., mkd. T5S R41E S21 BT.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base, the water
pipe within, and the corner stone alongside the stainless steel
post.

From this point, the corner of wire fences extending S. and E.,
bears S. 30° E., 0.130 chs. dist.

From the cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27.

S. $88^{\circ} 59' 00''$ W., bet. secs. 22 and 27.

Descend rocky W. slope.
