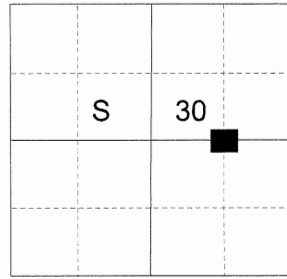

At position determined by survey set a 5/8"x30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below:

From which:

A 7" Douglas Fir bears East, a distance of 7.10 feet, marked CE 1/16 S30 BT.

A 13" Douglas Fir bears North 5° West, a distance of 14.55 feet, marked CE 1/16 S30 BT.

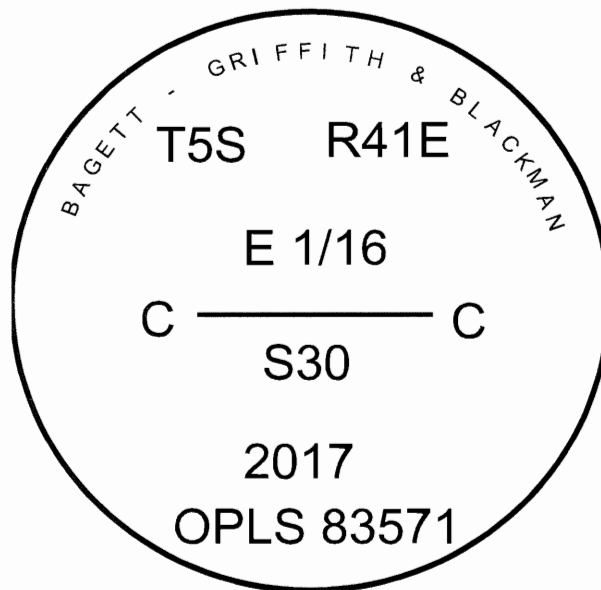
Set a steel fence post approx. 1 ft. North.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the bearing trees. Magnetic declination used was 13° East. Bearing is to a brass washer marked OPLS 83571 in the lower blaze of the tree. Distance is to a spike set in the root crown of the side of the tree.
