A larch, 17" ins. diam., bears S. 57° W., 41.0 ft. dist. (record 41.6 ft.), scribed "1/4 S36 BT".

#### Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From the brass cap, I established the following references:

Set a 1/2 ins. diam. by 24 ins. long, rebar, 23 ins. in the ground, S. 31° E., 138.4 feet, with brass washer mkd. LS 2211, RM 2, wire to the rebar, with a collar of stone.

Set a 1/2 ins. diam. by 24 ins. long, rebar, 23 ins. in the ground, S. 38° W., 126.2 feet, with brass washer mkd. LS 2211, RM 1, wire to the rebar, with a collar of stone.

I set steel post with a Property Boundary & a Land Survey Monument sign, North on line, 3.0 feet from the monument. Also, I set steel post with a Property Boundary sign, East on line, 3.0 feet from the monument.
