
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

40.29 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33, at proportionate distances; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap, from which:



A lodgepole pine, 9 ins. diam., bears S.21 3/4°E., 78 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S33 BT.

A lodgepole pine, 11 ins. diam., bears S.77°W., 13 lks. dist. mkd. 1/4 S32 BT.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base and set a 6 ft. steel fence post alongside the stainless steel post.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 2½" B.L.M. brass cap, 5" above ground, with a 2' mound of stone to cap, from which:

A pine, 10" diam., bears S.21°16'E., 51.20', with a 14" x 3" blaze, scribed "\$S33 BT". A pine, 12" diam., bears S.77°54'W., 8.82', with a 18" x 3" blaze, scribed "\square\sq

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

A tamarack, 12" diam., bears S.48°23'E., 11.40', with a 15" x 5" blaze, scribed "\$S33"

A tamarack, 14" diam., bears N.19°38'W., 28.25', with a 15" x 5" blaze, scribed "\$S32" BT".
