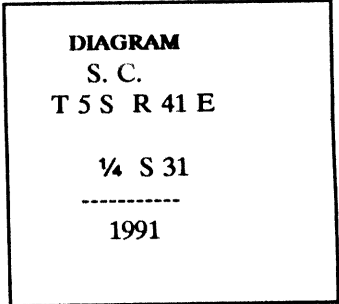


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION



History of original corner establishment:

40.175 The standard ¼ sec. cor, of sec. 31, determined at the center of an ancient stone mound with the original slate stone, 15 x 12 x 3 ins. (record, 12 x 12 x 3 ins.), loose alongside, mkd. ¼ on the N. face. Set a stainless steel post 28 ins long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap, from which:

- A ponderosa pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N.77°E., 27 lks. dist. mkd. ¼ S31 SC BT.
- A ponderosa pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N.50°W., 103 lks. dist. mkd. x at breast height and BT at the base.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base and the corner stone alongside the stainless steel post.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 2½" B.L.M. brass cap, 6" above ground, with a 1.5' mound of stone to cap, from which:

- A pine, 10" diam., bears N.77°08'E., 17.38', with a 17" blaze, scribed "¼ S31 SC BT".
- A pine, 13" diam., bears N.50°31'W., 67.83', with a 9" blaze, scribed "x" at breast height.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

- A pine, 13" diam., bears N.19°25'E., 45.71', with a 15" blaze, scribed "¼ S31 SC BT".
- A pine, 12" diam., bears S.16°58'W., 43.98', with a 21" blaze, scribed "¼ S31 SC BT".

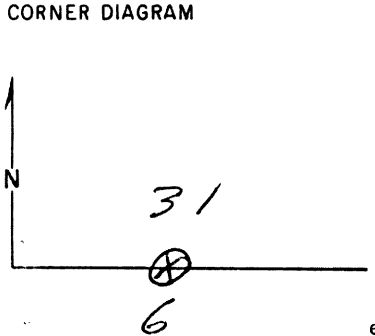
