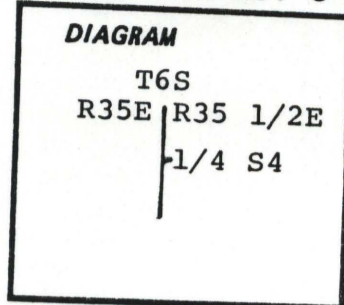


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. C-09

History of original corner establishment:

The original subdivision of T6S R35 1/2E was by E. McCornack under Contract No. 398, approved January 9, 1883. Set a post and 18x18x12 pitse. east and west of post 5.5 ft. and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high and 3.5 ft. across the base around the post.



Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument or other official accessories found.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: Corner set by proportion.

Cap is stamped:

Set 2.5" aluminum cap on 2 3/8"x30" aluminum pipe rising 6" above ground. Set 6 ft. steel fence post 3.0 ft. north of corner.

- A 5" L. Pine bears N40°E, 29.6 ft., blazed and scribed: 1/4 S4 BT.
- A 5" P. Pine bears S85°E, 33.3 ft., blazed and scribed: 1/4 S4 BT.

Brass LS 1844 disc in lower end of blazes. Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982.

Compass Declination: 19 3/4°E
