

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1883 by William B. Barr under contract #492. Set Pine Post 3"x3"x3', 24" in ground. From which:
A 12" fir bears East, 30 lks.
A 12" fir bears S45°W, 18 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument found.
BT's found:

A root crown that matches a 14" dead&down Fir with ½S visible bears S45°W, 18 lks. (Logging activity in the area appears to have moved this BT to the NW 10 ft.)
The root crown for a badly decayed fir with an open blazed slab bears East 30 lks., part of S&B visible.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Cap is stamped: T6S R35½E
From evidence, I set a 2½"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 5" in a mound of stones. S11|S12
Set steel fencepost 3 ft. North of corner. RLS1848

New BT's:
A 14" P. Pine bears N8°W, 7.3 ft., blazed&scribed: ½S11BT
A 10" W. Larch bears S67°E, 58.9 ft., blazed&scribed: ½S12BT

Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982. A ½" brass disk stamped "RLS 1848" was nailed to the lower end of the blazes.

From USFS Rd. 5178, follow Rd. 5178017 0.2 miles North to the East-West fence line. Follow fence West ¼ mile to fence corner. Corner is SW, approx. 80 ft.
