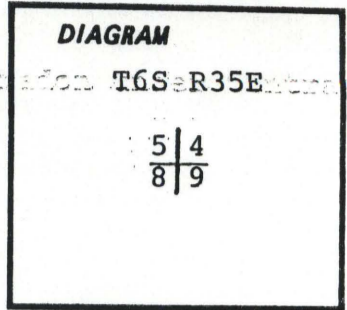


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. E-09

History of original corner establishment:

Original subdivision of T6S, R35E was by Herman D. Gradon under Contract No 499, approved November 24, 1884. At this corner he set a stone 17x12x6, from which an 8" Pine bears N73°E, 20 lks. and mounds.



Description of corner evidence found:

No corner monument found.

Bearing Trees Found:

A 24" Tamarack bears N58°E, 20.46 ft., scribing partly healed.  
A stump hole bears S15°W, 10 ft., with rotted remains of tree, scribing faint.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Cap is stamped:

Set 2.5" aluminum cap on 2 3/8"x30" aluminum pipe rising 11" above ground. Set steel fence post 3.0 ft. north of corner.

- A 6" Fir bears S55°E, 24.1 ft., blazed and scribed: T6S R35E S9 BT.

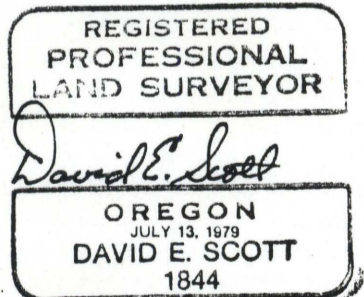
