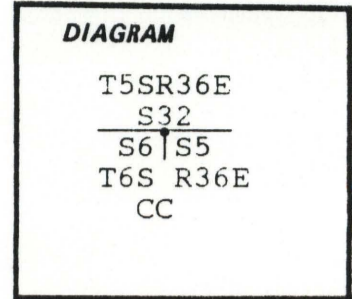


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1883 by William B. Barr under contract #492. He set a basalt stone 20"x12"x12" and dug pits S, E, & W. of corner.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Cap is stamped:  
Corner set by single proportioning. I set a 2½"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 7". Few stones available. Set steel fencepost 3' East of corner.

A 7" W. Larch bears S80½°W, 11.4 ft., blazed&scribed: T6SR36ES6CCBT

A 7" D. Fir bears S32°E, 51.3 ft., blazed&scribed: T6SR36ES5CCBT

Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982. A ¾" brass disk stamped "RLS 1848" was nailed to the lower end of the blazes.

From Rd. 5125, take Rd. 5178095 approx. 1 mile. Corner is across the draw to the East, 250 ft.
