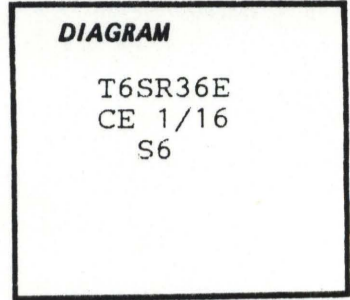

Corner set by single proportioning. I set a 2½"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 10" in a mound of stones. Set steel fencepost 3' South of corner.

A 9½" D. Fir bears N17½°W, 43.2 ft., blazed&scribed: CE1/16S6BT

Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982. A ¾" brass disk stamped "RLS 1848" was nailed to the lower end of the blazes.
