
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established by W. B. Barr under GLO contract number 492 dated August 22, 1883, Surveyor General record states: Set granite stone 15"x10"x8", 10 inches in the ground, marked 4 on the North face, from which:

A Pine 36" in diameter bears N  $10^{\circ}$  E, 27 1ks. distant, marked  $\mbox{4S}$  BT.

A Pine  $48^{\circ}$  in diameter bears S  $30^{\circ}$  E, 27 1ks. distant, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.



No subsequent record of remonumentation found in county record. Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 32" Ponderosa Pine open blaze with scribes showning. Tree bears S  $30^{\circ}\text{E}$ , 27 lks. distant. Tree alive and vigerous.

Found a 22" Ponderosa Pine open blaze with scribes showning. Tree bears N  $10^{\rm O}$  E, 27 lks. distant. Tree alive and vigerous.

Corner falls in a skid trail, no stone found at record bearing and distance.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: At position determined by record bearing and distnace from bearing trees, I set a 2½ x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26" in the ground, and raised a mound of stone.

No new bearing trees taken.
