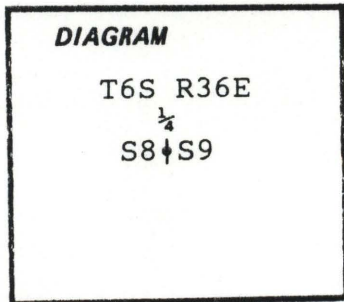


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1884 by William B. Barr under contract #492. Set a Pine post, 3½x3½x4', 24" in ground. From which:
A 10" Pine bears N30°E, 20 Lks.
A 10" Pine bears S20°W, 6 Lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of original post.
Found the following original bearing trees:
A 14" Lodgepole Pine bears N30°E, 20 Lks., open blaze; '¼SBT' visible.
An 11" Lodgepole Pine, dead & down, bears S20°W, 6 Lks., '¼SBT' visible in open blaze.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position established from the orig. bearing Trees, I set a 2½"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 5". No stones available. Set steel fence post 3 ft. North.

A 5" W. Larch bears N62½°E, 73.0 ft., blazed&scribed: ¼S9BT
A 9" W. Larch bears N39½°W, 68.7 ft., blazed&scribed: ¼S8BT

Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982. A ¾" brass disk stamped "RLS 1848" was nailed to the lower end of the blazes.

Go to East end of 5178159. Skid road goes East and curves North from landing. Corner is 250 ft. ENE from landing at the top of easterly slope.
