

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

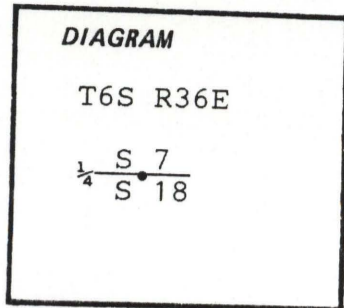

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established in 1883 by William B. Barr under contract #492. Set a pine post, 3"x3"x3' 24" in the ground.

From which:

- An 8" Pine bears N, 6 lks.
An 8" Pine bears S10°W, 18 lks.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found discoloration of soil and badly decayed remains of original post down to a foot below surface.

BT's found:

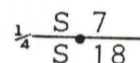
- A 13" dead and down lodgepole pine bears S20°W (Orig. S10°W), 18 lks. blaze healed on underside.
A 12" dead and down lodgepole pine; stump bears North 6 lks. from corner. I opened blaze. "BT" visible.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At location of remains of original post, I set a 2 1/2"x30" aluminum capped aluminum pipe rising 5" in a mound of stones and earth. Set steel fencepost 3 ft. North of corner.

Cap is stamped:

T6S R36E



New BT's:

RLS1848
1987

- A 6" W. Larch bears N54 1/2°W, 18.8 ft., blazed & scribed: 1/4 S 7 BT

- A 4 1/2" Western Larch bears S58 1/2°W, 73.9 ft., blazed & scribed: 1/4 S 18 BT

Painted blazes and attached signs as per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Surveys, USFS Region 6, March 1982. A 3/4" brass disk stamped "RLS 1848" was nailed to the lower end of the blazes.

Corner is approx. 65 ft. north of pond. Walk 21 chains west from a 10" white fir with location poster on east side of Rd. 5178085, 0.4 mi. south from 5178080.

Compass declination: 21°E
