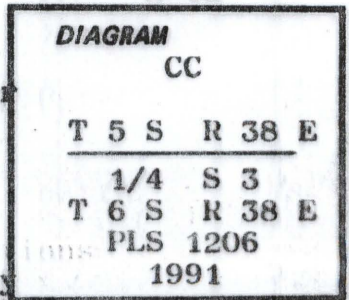


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

A-15

History of original corner establishment:

Thompson and Chapman set the NE corner of section 3 under GLO contract No. 104. W. Barr set the NW corner of section 3 under GLO contract No. 388. However in neither surveyors notes does it mention the setting of the North 1/4 corner of section 3.



J. W. Kimbrell, Union County Surveyor, subdivided sections 3,4,9 and 10 on December 7, 1889. His survey notes are on pages 224-227 of an old bound survey book on file in the Union County Surveyors Office. Kimbrell notes state:  
Set post for 1/4 sec corner between sec 3 & 34.

Description of corner evidence found:

None found. Corner point re-established on the 1st Standard Parallel South by single proportionate distance method between the Northeast and Northwest corners of section 3.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the re-established corner point, set 1 1/4" x 30" galv. iron pipe 18" into the ground, constructed 36" dia. stone mound around the monument. 2 1/2" dia. brass cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram.

From which, bearing trees:

A 12" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears N. 35° E., 96.8 feet dist. marked T6S R38E 1/4 S3 CC BT on double blaze.

A 12" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears S. 32° E., 78.0 feet dist. marked T6S R38E 1/4 S3 CC BT on double blaze.

An 11" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears S. 45° W., 47.7 feet dist. marked T6S R38E 1/4 S3 CC BT on double blaze.

A 14" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears N. 42° W., 253.0 feet dist. marked T6S R38E 1/4 S3 CC BT on double blaze.

Set steel fence post 2' east from the corner monument. Attached USFS 54-9 sign to the fence post. Also attached 54-9 and 54-3 signs to bearing trees.

I certify that the above corner was properly monumented under my direct supervision on July 12, 1991, as witnessed by Larry McBroom and David Smith.
