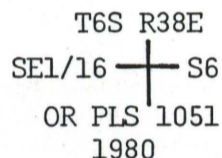


Description of corner evidence found:

Corner is about 100' SW of track road in old skid road.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:



At surveyed point set 1" X 36" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 30" in the ground and placed mound of atone around to cap.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E: A 10" Tamarac bears N21°W, 23.8 ft. scribed SE1/16S5 BT. A 10" Pine bears S55°W, 10.8 ft. scribed SE1/16S5 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed location tags, Do Not Cut tags, and CZ property corner tags and brass washers stamped PLS 1051. Placed 54-4 on steel fence post 5' North of the corner.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was reestablished as herein described.
