# History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by W. B. Barr, under G. L. O. contract No. 388, in September, 1881. Surveyors General's notes state; "Set stake 4 ft. long 4 in. diam. 18 in. in the ground for corner to secs. 1, 6, 7, 12. from which a pine 12 in. diam. bears N45°E, 8 lks. dist. a pine 5 in. diam. bears N55°W, 17 lks. dist., a pine 6 in. diam. bears \$40°W, 10 lks. dist., a pine 10 in. diam. bears \$53°E, 58 lks. dist."

#### Description of corner evidence found:

No trace of post could be found. Found an 11" Pine, N55°W, 11.2 ft. An 11" Pine, S46°E, 37.8 ft. Some visible scribing on old BTs. Old Bts have 54-3 and 54-4s. NW BT has two location tags.

Corner is about 125' north and east of roads.

# Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the center of the above described point set 2 1/2 T6SR38E X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked:
Set pipe 20" in the ground to bedrock and mound of stone around to cap.
From which: by magnetic declination of N20°E:
A 7" fir bears N77°E, 55. 7 ft. scribed T6SR38ES6
BT. An 11" pine bears S50°W, 41.2 ft. scribed T6SR37E BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and brass washer stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' South and 54-2 on steel fence post 5' East of corner.

#### History of original corner establishment:

Original corner set by William B. Barr, under GLO Contract No. 388, approved December 31, 1881.

Record states: Set stake 4 ft. long 4 in diam 18 in ground for corner to Sec 1, 6, 7, 12 from which: Pine, 12 in. diam., bears N 45° E, 8 lks. dist.

Pine, 5 in. diam., bears N 55° W, 17 lks. dist.

Pine, 6 in. diam., bears S 48° W, 10 lks. dist. Pine, 10 in. diam., bears S 53° E, 58 lks. dist.

Subsequent Monumentation:

Corner was remonumented by Barry B. Barbour, LS 1051, as described by File No. 765-84R, filed December 6, 1979, in the records of the Union County Surveyor.



At center of above described point set 21/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked (as shown below): Set pipe 20" in the ground to bedrock and mound of stone around to cap.

From which, by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 7" fir bears N77°E, 55.7 ft. scribed T6S R38E S6 BT.

An 11" pine bears S50°W, 41.2 ft. scribed T6SR37E BT.



### Description of corner evidence found:

Found 21/2 ins. diam. iron pipe, projecting 15 ins. above ground, with 3 ft. diam. mound of stone to top, and 21/2 ins. diam. brass cap, marked as shown:

From the recovered monument I find the original bearing trees:


A ponderosa pine, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 46° E., 37.8 ft. dist. to face, alive and healthy, with open blaze and E T6S S7 visible.

A ponderosa pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 55° W., 11.2 ft. dist. to face, alive and healthy, with healed blaze.

And accessories mkd. by Barbour:

A cut fir stump, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 77° E., 55.7 ft. dist., cut low with no scribing visible. A ponderosa pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 50° W., 41.2 ft. dist., alive and healthy, with mostly healed double blaze, scribing visible in lower blaze.

Found guard posts ±5 ft. S'ly; added Property Boundary (54-2) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs, and ±5 ft. E'ly, added Property Boundary (54-2) sign.



## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

New bearing tree:

A Douglas fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 80° E, 52.1 ft. dist., mkd. T6S R38E S6 BT.

New bearing tree marked on a single blaze and has a nail with a brass washer stamped "LS 2648" right side center for distance measurements

Painted 6 ins. red bands and added Bearing Tree (54-3) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs as needed to all bearing trees.
