Description of corner evidence found:

Found small mound of stone and painted rock about record size. No Markings could be found. Found a pine stump bearing S09°E, 51.1 ft. scribed "7 BT". A 39" pine stump bears N60°W, 30.6 ft., scribed "BT" on part of grown over blaze. 54-3s on old BT stumps.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At center of the above described stone, set 2 1/2"

X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked:
Set pipe 24" in the ground and mound of stone
around to cap.

From which: by magnetic declination of N20°E:
A 15" fir bears \$12°E, 32.5 ft. scribed 1/4\$7 BT.
A 9" pine bears N54°E, 36.3 ft. scribed 1/4\$6 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s and brass washer stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Old location tags on new SE BT, on a tree 35' north and 1978 tag on tree at road about 265' east.

PPlaced 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' East of corner.
