

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner set by Barry B. Barbour, LS 1051, as described by File No. 774-84R, filed June 26, 1981, in the records of the Union County Surveyor.

Corner falls on south edge of main road, near "Entering National Forest Land" sign. Road does not cross property line.



These are the 1979 BTs.




Description of corner evidence found:

Found $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam. iron pipe, projecting 4 ins. above ground, with rock collar, and $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam. brass cap, marked as shown:

From the recovered monument I find the Barbour bearing trees:

A Douglas Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 19° E., 28.5 ft. dist., alive and healthy, with healed double blaze. An 8' high pine stump, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 82° W., 16.4 ft. dist., with scribing visible on partially healed double blaze.

Found guard post ±5 ft. W'ly, added Property Boundary (54-2) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs.



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

New bearing tree:

A ponderosa pine, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 74° W., 71.2 ft. dist., mkd. NW1/16 S7 BT.

New bearing tree marked on a single blaze and has a nail with a brass washer stamped "LS 2648" right side center for distance measurements.

Painted 6 ins. red bands and added Bearing Tree (54-3) and Land Survey Monument (54-9) signs as needed to all bearing trees.
