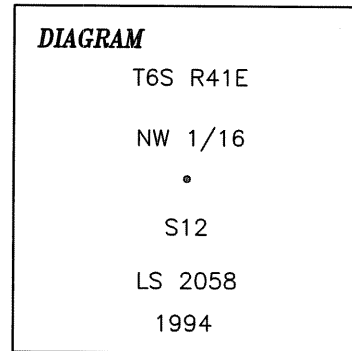

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established in 1994 by Ronald E. Stoll, PLS 2058, under U.S. Forest Service contract. Stoll's notes state:

Set a USFS 3 1/4" aluminum capped pipe, cap marked per diagram, 26" in ground with small mound of stone to cap. Point falls 20' +/- southerly E/W fence line and 175' +/- westerly fenceline to north.



Typical USFS Cap

A Fir, 7" diam., bears S83°15'W, 39.2', scribed: NW1/16 S12 BT.
A Pine, 10" diam., bears N04°40'W, 33.3', scribed: NW1/16 S12 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 3 1/4" USFS aluminum cap on aluminum pipe marked as shown in corner diagram 3" above ground.

From Which:

A Douglas Fir 8" in diameter bears S83°W (Record S83°15'W), 39.8' (Record 39.2') with visible scribing.
A Ponderosa Pine 11" in diameter bears N5°W (Record N04°40'W), 33.8' (Record 33.3') with visible scribing.

Steel fencepost with 54-2 and 54-9 signs bears west, 2.0'. Steel fencepost with 54-2 sign bears north, 2.2'.

Corner monument is south +/- 25' of east-west fenceline.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Corner monument probably moved by Stoll after bearing trees were taken. Bearing tree scribes do not quite face corner monument. Remeasure bearings and distances to both bearing trees. Distances measured from Stoll's chaining nails.

Bearing trees have 54-3 and 54-9 signs and a 6" red painted band. The bearing tree faces are also painted red.
