

At a proportionate position, Set a USFS  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " aluminum capped pipe 24" in the ground, with a mound of stone to cap, from which:

A pine, 14" diam., bears S.05°17'E., 118.08', scribed "1/4 S10 BT".

A pine, 16" diam., bears N.67°48'E., 110.78', scribed "1/4 S10 BT".

A pine, 18" diam., bears N.49°54'W., 34.18', scribed "1/4 S 9 BT".

A pine, 16" diam., bears \$.35°46'W., 43.36', scribed "1/4 \$9 BT".
