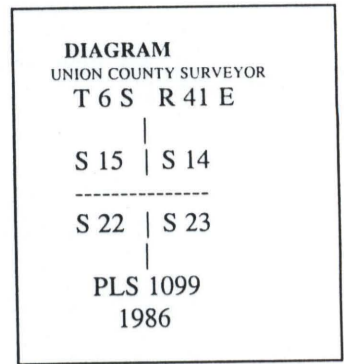


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

SURVEYED BY: W.B. BARR, 1885, CONTRACT NO. 516

SURVEYED BY: G. LANGLITZ, LS 1099, 1986, CORNER MONUMENT NO. 44-86R



Found original corner stone, a basalt stone 16"x8"x8" on place and upright, with three distinct chisel notches on the south edge and 4 chisel notches on the east edge. (I have no explanation for the presence of 4 notches on the east edge, insted of 2 notches which would be the normal markings for this corner.) The corner stone was supported in a small mound of stone.

At the position of the original corner stone, we set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe, 12" in the ground to bedrock and supported in a mound of stone 5 ft. diameter at base to top of pipe, with aluminum cap.

The original stone is buried along the south side of the aluminum pipe.

We mark the following new trees:

An 18" ponderosa pine, scribed " T6S R41E S14 BT" on a double blaze bears N25°E 75.6 ft.
A 14" ponderosa pine, scribed T6S R41E S22 BT" on a double blaze bears S46½°E 141.2 ft.
An 18" ponderosa pine, scribed "T6S R41E S22 BT" on a double blaze bears S76°W 12.3 ft.
And a 10" ponderosa pine, scribed "T6S R41E S15 BT" on a double blaze bears N28½°W 43.5 ft.

Attached brass washer marked "LS 1099" to lower blaze of new bearing trees.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 2½" aluminum capped pipe, cap marked per diagram, with a 5' diam. mound of stone, from which

A ponderosa pine, 13" diam., bears S.50°26'E., 140.62', with a 15" x 2" blaze, scribed "T6S R41E S23".

A ponderosa pine, 17" diam., bears N.22°28'E., 75.18', with a 19" x 2" blaze, scribed "T6S R41E S14".

A ponderosa pine, 11" diam., bears N.32°47'W., 43.37', with a 17" x 2" blaze, scribed "T6S R41E S15"

A ponderosa pine, 17" diam., bears S.74°38'W., 12.19', with a 14" x 2" blaze, scribed "T6S R41E S22".

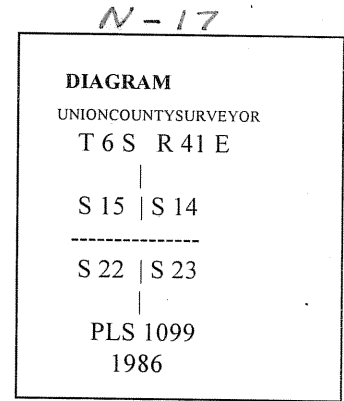
