
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner established by John Stone, under GLO Contract No. 235, dated July 6, 1875. Surveyor General field notes state:

Set stone 14x13x7 for 1/4 Sec. Cor. at foot of hill bears N70°W and S60°E



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a embedded stone mound, 3 ½ ft. diameter, stones are well embedded and are of a large size not typical of stone in the area. Area is relatively devoid of stones. I find a stone of called size, but can find no definitive marks. Due to harmony with section corner to the South, as well as to the topographic call, I accept this as the original corner monument.



DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position of the stone mound, I set a 2 ½" x 30" aluminum pipe with 3" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, 24 inches in the ground, in a collar of stone 3 ft. diameter, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8"x15" iron pin bears North 71°30' East, a distance of 22.80 feet, with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER NE RP
A 5/8"x15" iron pin bears South 24°30' East, a distance of 13.45 feet, with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER SE RP
A 5/8"x15" iron pin bears South 76°45' West, a distance of 17.25 feet, with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER SW RP
A 5/8"x15" iron pin bears North 15°30' West, a distance of 17.34 feet, with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER NW RP.
