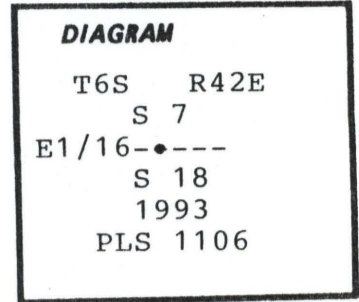


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At postion established by survey:

Set a 2½" X 30" aluminum pipe with a 2½" aluminum cap, 24" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone.

Attached sign 54-9 & 54-2 to steel fence post, set 4.0 feet West of monument.

Set a steel fence post 4.0 feet South of monument.

New bearing trees established:

A 11" douglas fir bears S 47° W - 18.2 feet, scribed: E1/16S18BT.

A 16" douglas fir bears N 86° E - 8.1 feet, scribed: E1/16S7BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped 'PLS 1106' nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each bearing tree.

I hereby certify that the above corner monument was properly monumented to U.S.F.S standards by me on December 3, 1993.
