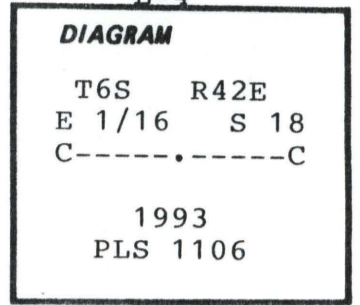


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At postion established by survey:

Set a 2½" X 30" aluminum pipe with a 2½" aluminum cap, 28" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone.

Attached sign 54-9 & 54-2 to steel fence post, set 3.0 feet North of monument.

Set a steel fence post 3.0 feet South of corner also.

New bearing trees established:

A 22" ponderosa pine bears N 19° E - 51.0 feet, scribed: C-E1/16S18BT.

A 18" douglas fir bears S 10° E - 23.5 feet, scribed: C-E1/16S18BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each bearing tree.
