

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At postion established by survey:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " X 30" aluminum pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap, 28" in ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone.

Attached sign 54-9 & 54-2 to steel fence post, set 3.8 feet West of monument.

Set a steel fence post 3.3 feet South of monument.

New bearing trees established:

A 31" ponderosa pine bears S 44° W -118.7 feet, scribed: C-W1/16S19BT. A 37" ponderosa pine bears S 79° E -227.6 feet, scribed: C-W1/16S19BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 & 54-9, painted face of blaze & a 6" red band around each bearing tree.
