1 Whereas Anna Larsen is the owner of eighty (80) acres of land
2 which is not reached by any convenient public read heretefere
3 provided for by law, and that it is necessary that the public and
4 said Anna Larsen have ingress to and egress from the land of said
5 Anna Larsen aforesaid;

6 Now therefore, in consideration of the sum of Thirty (\$30.00)
7 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the coven-
8 ant and agreement of the said Anna Larsen to establish and maintain
9 a lawful fence on the boundary line between the tract of land
10 hereinafter described and granted for road purposes and the premis-
11 es of granters out of which said road is granted, we the undersigned,
12 do hereby grant and dedicate the following described land, so far
13 as the same may be required for such road, to the County of Union,
14 State of Oregon, to that purpose and for the use of such road, viz.

15 Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section Twelve
16 (12), Township I North, Range 40 East of the Willamette Merid-
17 ian in Union County, State of Oregon, thence running East a
18 distance of eighty two (82) rods, thence running South a dis-
19 tance of Twenty (20) feet, thence running West a distance of
20 eighty two (82) rods, thence running North a distance of
21 Twenty (20) feet to the place of beginning.

22 And we do waive all claim for damages for and on account
23 of the location of said road.
