Mer. and running thence W. 30 ft.; thence W. 7 deg. 30 min, E. 42 ft.; thence S. 16 deg. 30 min. W. 142 Ft.; thence S. 9 deg. E. 84 ft.; thence S. 16 deg. E. 480 ft.; thence S. 33 deg. 30 min.
