and *Pearl McCall* his wife, for the consideration of *One Dollar*

and the joining DOLLARS.

to *them* paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

A strip of land 60 feet wide being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Old Oregon Trail Highway, La Grande-Hot Lake Section as surveyed over and across the S. $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23 T. 3 S. R. 38 E.W.M. Being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at Station 174756 of the survey of the Old Oregon Trail, La Grande - Hot Lake Section, which station is approximately 2810 feet North and 3615 feet West of the corner for Sections 23, 24, 25, 26 T. 3 S. R. 38, E.W.M. Thence running S $43^{\circ} 59'$ E. parallel and 80 feet from the centerline of the W.W.R.N.E.R. 4023 feet to Station 414778 of said survey, being approximately 770 feet West of the corner for sections 23, 24, 25, & 26 T. 3 S.
