**This Indenture, WITNESSETH, That Francis L Wade**

and **Mary E Wade** his wife, for the consideration of **One dollar**  
and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,

to them paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey  
unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

A strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet on each side of the center line of the LaGrande-Joseph Road, as surveyed over and across the S. W. 1/4 of Section 4, the N. E. 1/4 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 9, the N. E. 1/4 of Sec. 9, and the N. W. 1/4 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 10, all the T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M., and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the S. W. corner of the F. L. Wade property at Station 1533 plus 38 of the survey of the center line of said road, which station is approximately at the corner of Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M. running thence S. 89 18' E. 118 feet along the South line of the F. L. Wade property to the P. C. of a ten degree curve to the left thence entering the F. L. Wade property 403.2 to the P. T. thence N. 50 23' E. 227.8 feet to station 1540 plus 87.6, the P. C. of a 16 degree curve to the right, for 684.5 feet to a P. T. thence S. 20 06' E. 97.9 ft. emerging at station 1548 plus 70 of the survey of the center line of said Road which station is approximately 1266 ft. East of the corner of Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M.

Reentering the F. L. Wade property at station 1550 plus 81 of the survey of the center line of said Road said Station being a point on a 6 degree curve to the left thence on said curve 254.1 ft. to station 1553 plus 35.1, a P. T., thence S. 40. 04' E. 198.7 ft. to a P. C. thence on a 4 degree curve left for 305.4 ft., to a P. T. thence S. 52 17' 343.8 ft. thence on a 3 degree curve left for 213.8 ft., thence S. 58 42' E. 337.7 ft., thence on a 16 degree curve left for 216.9 ft. to station 1569 plus 92.8, passing at station 1568 plus 45 approximately 1308 ft. South of the 1/4 cor. between Sections 4, and 9, T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M., from station 1569 plus 92.8 thence N. 79 20' E. 17.3 ft., thence on an 8 degree curve right for 316.9 ft., thence S. 83 19' E. 4.1 feet., thence a 12 degree curve left 291.5 ft., thence N. 61 42' E. 217.6 ft., thence a 6 degree curve left 279.6 ft., thence N. 44 56 E. 171.5 ft., thence 10 degree curve right 250.8 ft., thence N. 70 25 E. 32.9 ft. thence a 10 degree curve left 230.00 ft., thence N. 47 25' E. 116.0 ft., thence a 10 degree curve right for 479.2 ft., thence S. 84 40' E. 226.8 ft., thence an 8 degree curve left for 365.8 ft. to station 1598 plus 96.0 P. T. Station 1597 plus 17.2 P. I. is S. 2 06' W. 402.0 ft. from the corner of Sections 3, 4, 9, and 10 T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M. From station 1598 plus 96.0 thence N. 66 04' E. 140.5 ft., thence an 8 degree curve right for 384.8 ft., thence S. 83 09' E. 225.8 ft., thence a 4 degree curve left for 337.1 ft., thence N. 83 22' E. 58.8 ft. more or less to an intersection with the East boundary of the F. L. Wade property at station 1610 plus 43 of said survey, which station is approximately 1280.0 ft. East and 233.2 ft. South of the corner of Section 3, 4, 9 and 10 T. 1 N. R. 40 E. W. M., containing 9.54 acres, more or less, in addition to land now used for County roads.
