This Indenture, WITNESSETH, That James Elliott

and Florence M Elliott his wife, for the consideration of

..... DOLLARS,

to them paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:

A strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet on each side of the center line of the La Grande-Joseph Highway, as surveyed over and across the  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Northwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 1 N., R. 39 E. of the W. M., and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the North boundary of the Jas. Eliot property and the La Grande-Joseph Highway, at station 1273 plus 08 of the survey of the center line of said highway, which station is approximately 2204.6 South and 919.3 ft. West of the 1/16 corner at the N. E. corner of the W. 1/2 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 14, T. 1, N. R. 39, E. W. M. running thence on a 10 degree curve left 187.1 ft., thence N. 17 22' E. 3.6 ft., thence on a 9 degree curve right 291.5 ft. thence N. 43 36' E. 253.6 ft. thence on a 4 degree curve left 375.8 ft. thence N. 28 34' E. 495.7 ft., thence 5 degree curve right 82.7 ft., to an intersection with the east boundary line of the Jas. Eliot property at station 1289 plus 98 of said survey, which station is approximately 794 ft. south of the 1/16 corner at the N. E. corner of the W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W. 1/4 of section 14 T. 1 N. R. 39, E. W. M. containing 2.33 acres, more or less, and of which approximately 0.75 acres is in right of way of present road.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said Union County and the public therein forever, and they, the said James Elliott and Florence M Elliott do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County that they are the owner in fee simple of said lands; that they are free from all encumbrances except
