This Indenture, WITNESS I H I that J. E. Reynolds

and Edna E. Reynolds his wife for the consideration of One Dollar and  
other valuable considerations,

to them paid have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey,  
unto the County of Union State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes to wit

A strip of land sixty (60) feet wide, the same being thirty (30) feet  
on each side of a line running parallel to and eighty five (85) feet south  
of the center line of the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Com-  
pany's railroad track, thru the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 15, Tp. 3, S.R. 38, L.W.M., in Union  
County, Oregon,

To Have and to Hold the said land, with its appurtenances for county road purposes to said Union  
County and the public therein forever, and we, the said J. E. Reynolds and Edna E.  
Reynolds, his wife, do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County that  
we are the owner in fee simple of said lands, that they are free from all encumbrances except
