This Indenture, WITNESSETH, That Ed Wulf

to them paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey  
unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit:  
A strip of land 60 ft. wide being 30 ft. on each <sup>side</sup> ~~end~~ of the center  
line survey of Old Oregon Trail as staked over and across the Land of Ed.  
Wulf, in the SE 1/4 of Sec. 7, Tier 5 S. Range 40 E.W.M. more particularly  
described as follows: Commencing at Engineers Sta. 216 plus 20 which point  
is approximately 1740 ft. west and 85 ft. South of the East 1/4 corner Sec.  
7 Tier and Range aforesaid. thence along said center line survey in a South-  
Easterly direction 2243 ft. more or less to Engineers Sta. 238 plus 63  
which point is approximately 1090 ft. North of the SE cor. of Said Sec. 7  
except that portion heretofore dedicated by use or otherwise as a Public Road.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said
