

and *Amelia Butterfield* his wife, for the consideration of *One Dollar and other valuable consideration* DOLLARS

to *them* paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Union, State of Oregon, the following described land for road purposes, to-wit: A strip of land 60 ft. wide, being 30 ft. on each side of the Center line survey of Old Oregon Trail as staked over and across the land of Marr and Butterfield, in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 8, and the Northwest 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 17 and the S. 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Sec. 17, all in Tier 5, S. Range 40 E. W. M. more particularly described as follows: Commencing at Engineers Sta. 238 plus 63, which point is approximately 1090 ft. N. of the SW cor. of Said Sec. 8, thence along said center line survey in a Southeasterly direction 4253 ft. more or less to Engineers Sta. 281 plus 16 which point is approximately 1806 ft. E. of the West 1/4 cor. of Said Sec. 17, except that portion heretofore dedicated by use or otherwise as a Public Road.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said land, with its appurtenances, for county road purposes to said Union County and the public therein forever, and *Me*, the said *Amelia Butterfield* do hereby covenant to and with the said Union County that *we are* the owners in fee simple of said lands; that they are free from all encumbrances except
