Tier 5 South Range 40 E.W. N. more particularly described as follows: Commencing at Engineers Sta. 281 plus 16. which point is approximately 1806 ft. E. of the W. 1/4 cor. of Said Sec. 17, thence along said Center line Survey in a Southeasterly direction 2844 ft. more or less to Engineers Sta. 309 plus 60 which point is approximately 200 ft. West. of the S. 1/4 cor. of said Sec. 17, except that portion heretofore dedicated by use or otherwise as a Public Road.
